The America-Nepal Friendship Society (ANFS) is shocked and saddened to hear of the senseless violence and inhumane killings of innocent people in Kapilvastu and other neighboring areas in Western Nepal. ANFS condemns the actions of all parties involved in these atrocities as gross violations of international human rights accords.

The killing of civilians is a crime against humanity. ANFS calls on all local parties, both governmental and civilian, to restrain from further violence and settle any differences through dialog and negotiation.
